In this sermon series beginning next **Sunday, February 7**, we will study the different types of psalms, learn about the nature of God and his great love for us, and develop our voices for praying and singing to the Lord.

While the Sunday sermons will focus on one specific psalm, you're invited to read and pray five psalms a day throughout this series. So on Feb. 1st, read Psalms 1-5; on Feb. 2nd, read Psalms 6-10 (and so on). In one month, we'll have prayed all the psalms, cultivated expressions of faith that will draw us closer to the Lord, and equipped ourselves to be **ready for anything!**


