
While each Sunday's sermon will focus on one specific psalm, you're invited to read and pray five psalms a day throughout this series. This

DISCUSS TOGETHER



Here are our discipleship questions for this week. Discuss these with your family or friends, or pray about them and think about them on your own, being open to God's response to your prayer.



- Read Psalm 13 and write a Response Prayer.
- Describe a particularly disorienting time in your life.
- Laments show us that we can be brutally honest with God in our prayers. Are there certain things you feel like you can't or shouldn't say to God in prayer?
- Take something going on in your life before God in the form of a lament prayer:
 - Address: "Lord..."
 - Complaint: "Here's the problem...here's what it's doing to me..."
 - Petition: Lord, I need you to..."
 - Expression of Trust: I will still trust You because..."



Sundays at 10 am our four-week Zoom Bible class on discipleship continues. Each Sunday we are watching a short, engaging video about the life and teachings of Jesus, then talking about how this will help us grow as his followers. These sessions are also designed to equip us to fulfill Christ's great commission to go and make disciples.
