When you're all finished, send your photos to Jacob either by:



# WELCOME!

We're delighted to be worshipping together indoors again! We are also live-streaming our worship broadcast - please be patient as we work to refine this online worship experience in the weeks to come.

We strongly encourage those of you who have any cold or flu-like symptoms such as cough, fever, chills, etc. to stay home and participate in our online livestream worship while you recover.

To minimize time spent indoors, our worship services will be 1 hour (or less) in duration. We will get to pray, sing, commune, and hear God's Word together!

For now, we are asking everyone to wear wellfitting face masks both inside and outside during our worship gatherings. Thank you for coming prepared to wear your mask safely on Sunday!

Children are most welcome to join our worship service! We love kids and are happy to see (and hear) them! During this initial phase of regathering, both the nursery and Kids' Worship are temporarily on hiatus. We are working on getting these safely up and running, so for now please be prepared to keep your kids engaged during the service. To help you with that, there are clipboards with activity pages hanging along the right hand wall of the sanctuary. You may grab one for each of your kids to use, and rehang them at the end of the service. We'll take care of sanitizing and preparing them for next week.

The Family Room will be available for use by families with young children, and the space can safely accommodate only one family at a time.

The doors will open at 10:30am. Upon entering the building, we'll take your temperature, then please stop at one of our hand-sanitizing stations, pick up your communion cup and a printed newsletter, and find a place to sit in our main auditorium. Chairs are grouped to observe safe distancing standards and to accommodate different sizes of family units and existing social bubble groups. You may want to arrive a few minutes before 10:45am to make sure you find a spot that fits you and your group (thanks for staying socially distanced while waiting outside). If you need help finding a seat, one of our ushers will happily direct you to a spot or move chairs to accommodate you.

Once our service is over, we'll all quickly move outside to the Courtyard for fellowship and visiting. We know many of us are used to hugs and handshakes as part of a typical Sunday morning greeting, and we miss this very much. But for now, please refrain from any physical contact with people outside of your household group.

The Family Life Center as well as the side classrooms and offices of the Worship Center will be closed. You can find our detailed plan for indoor worship services - including a section of frequently asked questions - at this link: www.trivalleychurch.org

The most important thing is that we worship our Lord on Sundays, regardless of the location. Those of our church family who may not be joining us in person will be greatly missed!
