If you aren't able to make your own video, you can arrange a time to come by the church office Mon-Thur and I will help you film it. I will need to receive or film all of these reflections by 12:00pm on Wed, April 14th.

WELCOME TO WORSHIP!

We're happy you are here with us today! For those who can't be present in person, we're live-streaming our Sunday worship. Please be patient as we continue working to refine this online worship experience in the weeks to come. We strongly encourage those of you who have any cold or flu-like symptoms such as cough, fever, chills, etc. to stay home and participate in our online livestream worship while you recover your health - you will be in our prayers.

- Our worship services will be 1 hour (or less) in duration. We'll get to pray, sing, commune, and hear God's Word together! Below are some points to help you have a safe and satisfying worship experience. Doors will open at 10:30am. Here's the current routine:
- Maintain 6 foot distancing from non-family/non-social-bubble members.
- Wear well-fitting face masks both indoors and outdoors during our worship gatherings.
- Greeters will take your temperature.
- Use hand sanitizer, pick up your communion cup, and pick up a printed newsletter.
- Find a place to sit in our main auditorium (ushers are there to help).
- Kids are very welcome in our worship service! We love them and are happy to see (and hear) them! There are labeled clipboards with activity pages hanging on the right hand wall of the sanctuary. Grab one for each kid, and return them after services - we'll sanitize and prepare them for next week.
- The Family Room is available for use, and can safely accommodate one family at a time. You are always free to go to the Courtyard if your child needs more space to move about during the service.
- At the end of service, we'll all quickly move outside to the Courtyard for fellowship and visiting.
- We all really miss hugs and handshakes, but for now, please refrain from any physical contact with people outside of your household group. The most important thing is that we worship our Lord on Sundays, regardless of the location.

Those of our church family who may not be joining us in person are always greatly missed! We love you all and appreciate your faithful prayers and words of support.

- Film with your device set up horizontally (not vertically).
- Film in a quiet location without a lot of background noise.
- Don't sit too far from the filming device or else the microphone won't pick up your voice as well (2-4 feet away is good).
