CELEBRATING OUR SENIOR STUDENTS

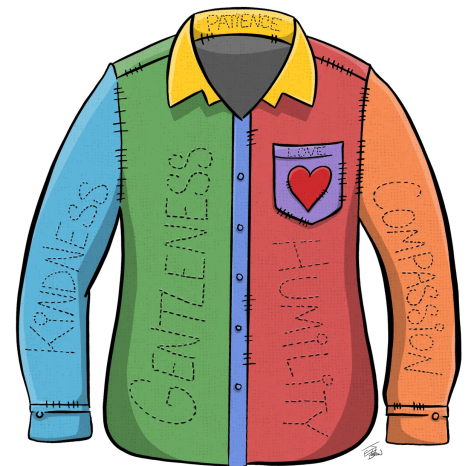

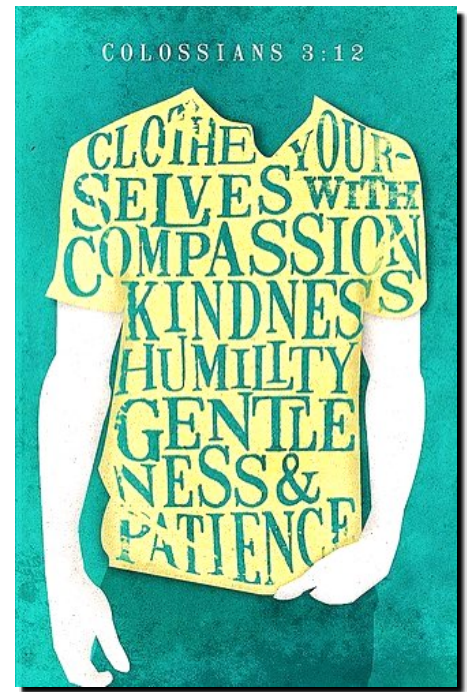


Our Teen Devo will meet this **Thursday, May 20 at 7 pm**. Bring your Bible and come prepared to share in faith-based discussions together.
