On Sundays this summer we are studying through the exciting New Testament book of 1 Peter. Hearing Peter's words will help us find a second wind for our faith as well, as we hold onto the solid faith we have in Jesus Christ.

Check out the **Discipleship Questions** in the green box to the right. These are things for us to think about this week and discuss with family members or friends as we encourage one another, or we can ponder them on our own in prayer and journal about them.

Read 1 Peter 1:1-12 & write a Response Prayer.

- Read: After you've read 1 Peter 1:1-12, find a word or phrase Peter uses to describe and celebrate the good news about Jesus that you really like.
- Reflect: Describe a way that someone encouraged you in your faith in Jesus that really meant a lot to you.
- Identify someone you're close to with whom you'd like to pray together more often. Reach out and let them know you'd like to pray together more often.
- Invite: Name one person or family you can invite to church or to read the Bible with you.
