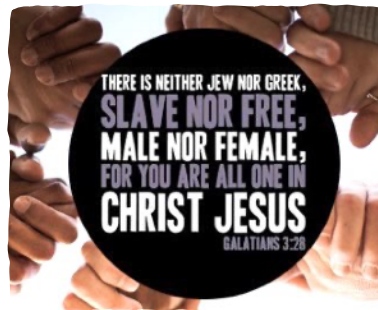

If you love kids and would like to help with our Children's Ministry (CM), please join our CM Team!

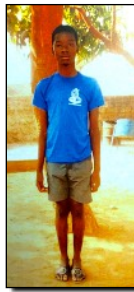

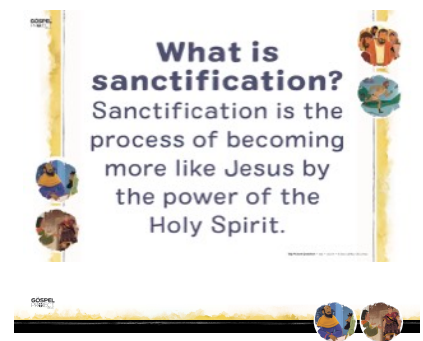
