## NEW MASK PROTOCOL

TVCC leadership regrets to inform you that we must go back to all members wearing masks when people gather together inside the building for any purpose. As of August 3, Alameda County reinstated a mask mandate requiring masks to be worn indoors in public settings, regardless of vaccination status. Here is the summary of the mandate:

*This Order requires all individuals within the County of Alameda to wear face coverings when indoors in workplaces and public settings, with limited exemptions, and recommends that businesses make face coverings available to individuals entering the business.*

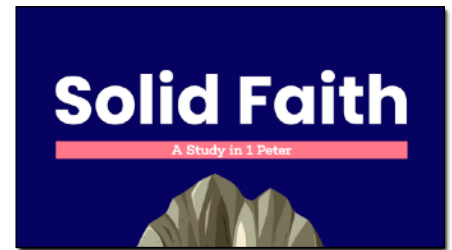
