Elfing is Here!

Every year during the holiday season, the youth group starts to accept Elfing orders. It costs \$40 to elf a house and all of the proceeds go to Agape Villages. Teens will go out and decorate someone's yard with red and green balloons, two elf cutouts, and a sign. We will start accepting orders on November 28th and we will accept them through December 19th. If you want to get involved, here are some things you can do!



-Place an order! It's \$40 and all we need from you is the name of the person being elfed, their address, and what you want the sign to say. Our signs have just enough space for your name to be added or something else such as "Your Neighbor" or "Anonymous." The teens take care of the rest!

-Volunteer to drive! On Wednesday nights during the month of December, teens will be going out and Elfing houses. If you are able and willing, it would be great to have you drive some teens around Livermore to get orders done.

-Do some Elfing! You can come on Wednesday nights and join in on the Elfing fun! If you want to elf houses but aren't comfortable riding with or driving other people, you could take some kits home. Everything will be provided, you just have to elf the person. Kids love Elfing and it's a great way to spend family time together.

Invite them!

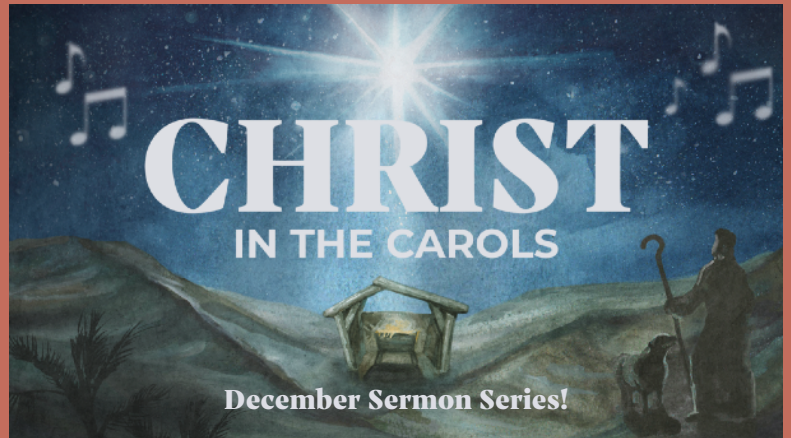
Children's Ministry New Year's Eve Day Party!
