Option 1: *The Tech-Wise Family* with Jacob and Lisa Parnell in Room 7 Technology has brought good in many ways, but it can also have unforeseen consequences, for ourselves, our children, and our relationships. Being Tech-Wise is about more than just setting time limits or internet filters. It's about using digital media in self-controlled ways, in line with the character we want to develop in ourselves and our families. Based on the book, The Tech-Wise Family by Andy Crouch, we'll use theological and practical lenses for discussing the issues of technology.

Option 2: A Clash of Kingdoms and Cultures in Conflict, in Room 6 (teachers TBD) How do you live in a culture where the worldview conflicts with Christianity, or where there are so many messages proclaimed as "good news" but are far from the gospel of Christ? Paul addressed these issues in the cities of Philippi, Corinth, and Athens declaring Jesus as Lord and the gospel of Christ as the true good news. This series, with videos by Ray Vander Laan, explores the historical context of the letters to the Philippians and Corinthians while also making connections with our own post-Christian context and offering ways we can live to glorify God here and now.




